



PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICLE SAFETY TRAINING PROCEDURE

1302.46 Family support services for health, nutrition and mental health.

- (a) *Parent collaboration*. Programs must collaborate with parents to promote children's health and well-being by providing medical, oral, nutrition and mental health education support services that are understandable to individuals, including individuals with low health literacy.
- (v) Learn about appropriate vehicle and pedestrian safety for keeping children safe.

Procedure:

Part-Day Sites:

- Pedestrian Safety training will be conducted within the first 60 days of the program year and as
- Teachers and teaching staff will use the Talk About Touch (*Unit I Lesson 2—Learning Traffic Safety*) curriculum as the training material, and will be able to enhance with other materials if they choose; for example, safe kids curriculum, videos, brochures, and games.
- Each center will put the certificate and sign in sheet in the Family Notebook.

EHS and Head Start Full Day/Full Year Program Options:

- Pedestrian Safety training will be conducted within the first 60 days of the program year, preferable at the First Family Gathering or Socialization of the year, and as needed.
- Staff will use the Talk About Touch (*Unit I Lesson 2—Learning Traffic Safety*) curriculum as the training material and will be able to enhance with other materials if they choose; for example, safe kids curriculum, videos, brochures and games.
- Each program option will put the certificate and sign in sheet in the Family Notebook/Socialization Notebook.
